

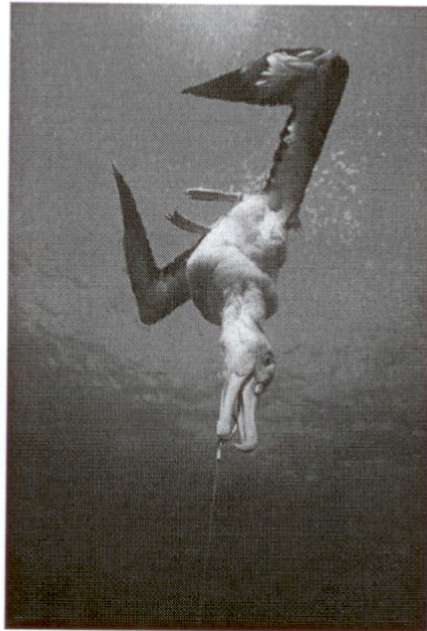
ALBATROSSES NEED HELP!!!

Every year, tens of thousands of albatrosses and petrels get killed in the world's longline fisheries when they unwittingly seize baited hooks intended for catching fish. This mortality has caused large decreases in these seabird populations, is ongoing and is threatening the existence of many species.

Efforts to make longline fisheries safe for seabirds are being hampered by the lack of funds, particularly to support initiatives in developing countries.

A Seabird Conservation in Fisheries advisory group has been established to identify key issues and research priorities. The group includes:
